

Beef and dairy odor Composting

Introduction

WHILE composting transforms organic residuals into useful fertilizer, it also can produce odors during the decomposition process . Problems arise particularly when neighbors live close to working sites. That reality makes those operating in more isolated locations fortunate, especially when potentially odorous feed stocks are being processed.

When dairy products begin to spoil, it creates an unpleasant, rancid odor due to the overgrowth of bacteria. This can attract pests and wildlife which can disrupt the compost pile in search of food.

Ammonia smell when turning the pile. Excess nitrogen within the pile can cause an ammonia smell and anerobic conditions that are apparent when disturbing the pile by flipping the materials. . When carbon-rich materials become saturated in wet weather, they can become compacted and fester within the pile, further adding to the ammonia odor. Materials such meat or dairy products can cause a rotten odor.
